

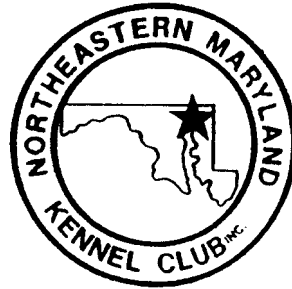

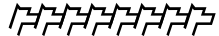

NEMKC PEE WEE Event 2026

Friday, July 3rd & Saturday, July 4th

- ❖ Pee Wee Class is a pre-junior showmanship class for children who are at least age 5 and under age 9 years on the date of the show.
- ❖ Dog must be at least four (4) months of age to enter and be handled
- ❖ All dogs must have proper leash and collar
- ❖ Day of entries close one hour prior to ring time.
- ❖ Judges: To be announced day of event



This is not a competition, but rather a fun and educational learning experience. Each child is accompanied into the ring by a responsible adult who stays with the child always; only one Pee Wee Handler and one adult will be in the ring at any one time.

The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside the ring as well as ensure control inside the ring. A primary goal is safety and a positive experience for the children, so at the judge's discretion, the adult may be required to attach a second leash to the dog in the ring. A dog demonstrating any aggressive behavior will be asked to leave the show grounds

Eligible dogs include AKC recognized breeds, Miscellaneous/FSS breeds, dogs with a PAL/ILP listing, and All-American dogs. Bitches in season are not allowed to participate (eligible dogs may be substituted). Dogs must have a proper leash and collar. An AKC licensed junior showmanship judge will be officiating at this event.

All Pee Wee participants must sign and return a "Release of Liability" form signed by a parent or guardian before they will be allowed to enter the show ring.

The Liability and Sign-up sheet can be completed at the club table prior to 10:00 a.m. on the day of the show.

Prizes include: Participation Ribbon & Goodie Bag offered by the Northeastern Maryland Kennel Club (NEMKC). NEMKC invites the children, parents/guardian to stay for a sweet treat.

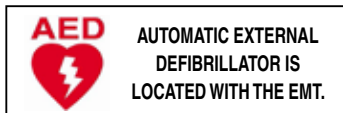

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SITE CONTROL will have the final authority on setup & grooming space. They will supervise all grooming setups & remove unapproved placement of equipment & chair.

Show Building will be available when ready, but not before 2:00 P.M. Thursday. Building will close at 9:00 P.M. Thursday.

Building opens at 6:00 A.M. on Friday, Saturday & Sunday. Building will close at 10:00 P.M. Friday & Saturday.

NO dogs will be permitted in the building overnight.

Free Grooming space will be provided.

CRATING: No soft crates allowed. There will be NO SPACE SAVING by any means. All crates & tables must be present at setup. The number of grooming tables may be limited and no rugs, blankets or matting on floor of building. Exhibitors and handlers are responsible for clean conditions in & around their setup.

No extension cords may be laid across aisles. Use wall or electric ceiling drops. No extension cords can be run to outside of building.

Place all trash in provided cans or plastic bags.

There is a parking fee for RVs of \$55.00 per night with advance reservation or **\$65.00** without advanced reservation (limited electric available).

Limited Handicapped Parking available.

Declination of Entries. The kennel clubs may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the kennel clubs or any official thereof.

All Entries must be paid for by instruments that will NOT be returned for insufficient funds.

The following breeds must be judged on a Ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Lagotto Romagnolo, Clumber Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Cirnechi dell'Etna, Kerry Blue Terriers, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, Keeshonden, Spanish Water Dogs. Breeds designated as ramp optional may, at the discretion of the judge, be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition. Judges may request the ramp to judge any breed in emergency situations; if granted, unless the use of a ramp has been indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. Junior Showmanship judges should follow the above.

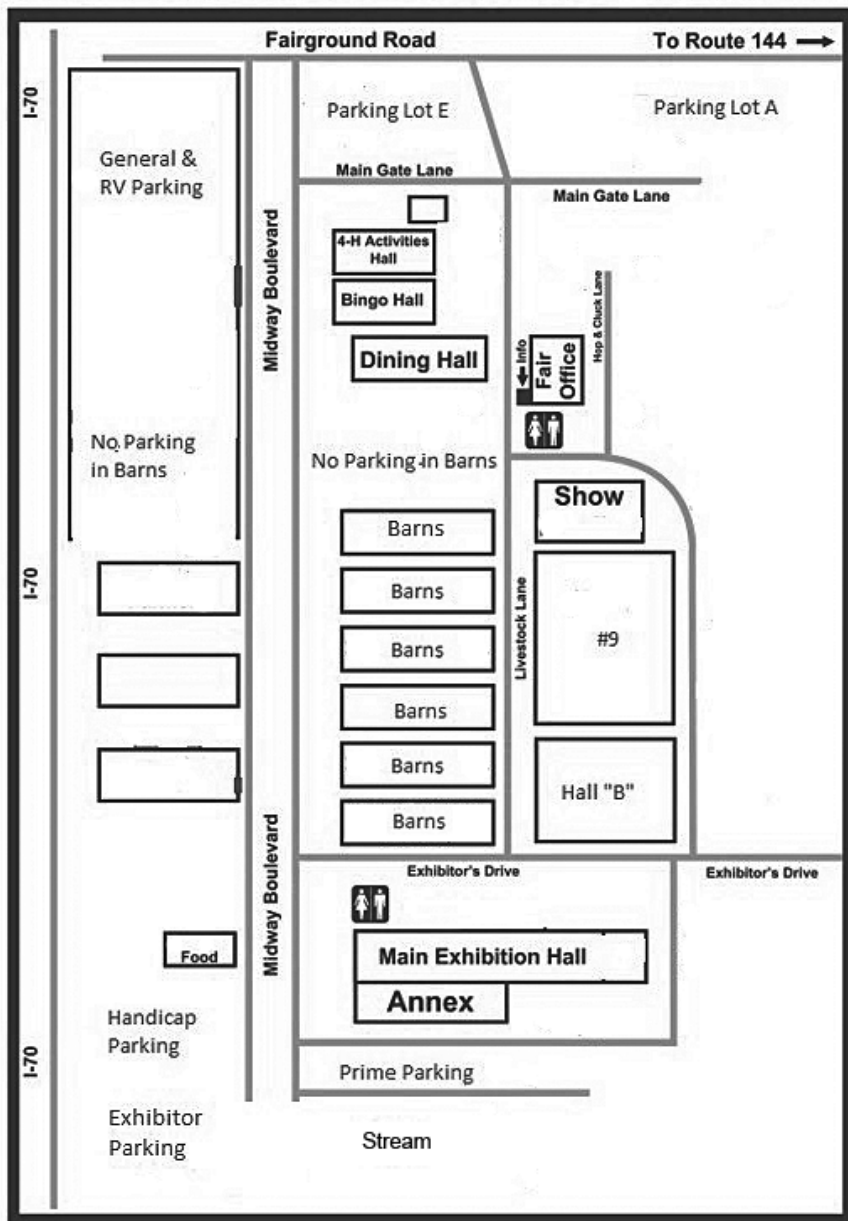

This is a recorded event by the AKC for the Certificate of Merit and Puppy of Achievement certificates.

Section 1 - Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over, but under six months on the first day of the event. Classes will be offered for breed and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

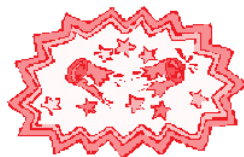

Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Superintendent assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. Tabulate carefully. Due to cost of processing, no refunds \$5.00 and under will be made.

Post Dated Checks, Returned Checks and Declined Credit Cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check or declined card. Subsequent returned checks or declined cards from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.

CHARGEBACKS on Credit Cards are considered a violation of your agreement to pay the required entry fee for entry into a show and the AKC Compliance Dept. will be notified for their disciplinary action. Also, if this remains a bad debt, the club may decline future entries for their shows and the superintendent will decline future entries for ANY show submitted via any method of payment until the debt is paid (Chap 11, Sec 15, AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows). Thereafter, the superintendent will refuse all future credit card entries from the exhibitor. All future entries must be paid for in cash or by money order or check.

An AKC Recording and Service Fee of \$4.50 for each entry. An AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy and Open Show. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. **(There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions.)**

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the event, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline (877) 252-3229.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. **An Administrative Fee of \$5.00 will be charged or withheld from refunds for duplicate entries.**

An Administrative Fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Each Owner and Agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at a show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed & submitted the entry form.

As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.**

Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

Class Cash Prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Superintendent's Office advised at once. The Superintendent and Show-Giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

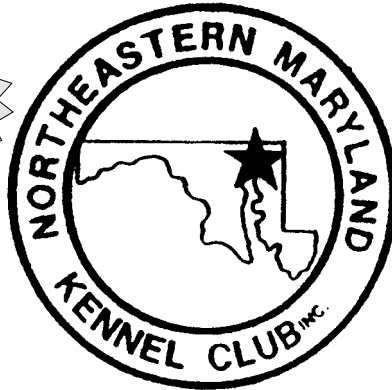
